Bus Information for SM Early Childhood Education Center



- Who is eligible for bus service to & from Shawnee Mission Early Childhood Education Center (SMECEC)? Students who have an IEP that includes bus transportation are eligible for free bus transportation to and from school.
- How do parents set up bus transportation for their student? Parents need to contact their child's teacher to put in the request for transportation, if the student is eligible.
- Who do I contact if there needs to be a change in bus service? Parents should contact their child's teacher who will then enter the changes. It can take up to a week to implement a change if it means a new bus or route.
- Who do I contact if my child is sick so not going to ride the bus? Call the office at your child's school. 913-993-2600
- How do parents know if a bus is going to be delayed? Textcaster is an alert system that sends updates on bus information. It sends alerts by either e-mail or text when a bus is delayed greater than 10 minutes from the scheduled times. Parents can sign up with Textcaster to receive alerts for the specific bus(es) their child rides. To sign up for these alerts, click <u>HERE</u>.
