If for any reason your student will be late, absent or have an early dismissal from school, please call the 24-HOUR ATTENDANCE LINE by no later than 9:15am the day they will be absent. We ask that you please not send an email for your students' attendance, we need to have one location for attendance and recorded on the 24-Hour Attendance Line. We thank you for your continued support.

School Fees

The online fee payment program is available on September 4, 2020. Please <u>click HERE</u> and pay your student's fees.

If students have a medical card with the State of Kansas, please send a copy of the card or the card number to patdeveau@smsd.org. Our bookkeeper, Pat DeVeau, will check the KANCARE status and notify you by email if you are not on the KANCARE 19 (TITLE XIX MEDICAID APPROVAL) program. The KANCARE 19 status waives the textbook rental and ID fees. Families will be required to pay any course or optional fees.

Please go to the online program above to check the amount due for your student. Please also put your student's name and ID number in the memo section of your check and write your phone number on the check.

Food Service

The food service department is pleased to announce that we will be offering **FREE meals to all SMSD students** regardless if they are learning remote, hybrid or in person. This includes breakfast and lunch meals. Meals that were picked up on Friday 9/4/20 will not be charged to the student's account.

Meals are funded entirely by USDA as part of their Summer Meals Program extension. These free meals will continue as long as federal funding is available and could end prior to 12/31/20. We encourage families to continue to apply for free and reduced meals in the event the funding is no longer available by clicking here. Qualifying may allow for other support through the district so it is important to continue to apply for free and reduced meals.

- Meals will be available for pick up at all 47 SMSD schools.
- Pick up is on Fridays from 7:00 a.m. 9:00 a.m.

- No advance ordering is needed. (The online digital ordering system has been disabled.)
- Available only for students enrolled in SMSD.
- May pick up meals for all of your students at your most convenient location.
- At pick up, the student(s) SMSD ID number(s) will need to be presented.
 Please have this ready in advance. (Student ID may be found in Skyward.)
- Pick up will be just inside the doors of school. Pease wear a mask and follow social distancing.

During remote learning each week's pick up will include 7 breakfast and 7 lunches for each student. Menus are available on the district web page by clicking here and are subject to change due to availability. All entrées and sides need to be taken home and refrigerated or frozen until ready to heat or consume.
