

During the March 12, 2020 Shawnee Mission Board of Education special meeting, the Board approved the contract for the 2019-2020 school year that was ratified by National Education Association-Shawnee Mission (NEA-SM) members. Ratification took place on March 9-11. This will be the sole contract for all members of the bargaining unit for this year.

Before the conclusion of the special meeting, Superintendent Mike Fulton provided an update to the Board on the district's plans and response related to COVID-19. Dr. Fulton shared the priority is the safety of students and staff. Information was shared with families and members of the community today about students taking home devices and educational resources. Schools and facilities will undergo a deep cleaning during Spring Break. District leaders are continuing to work closely with the Johnson County Department of Health and Environment (JCDHE). Additional communication and information will be provided as a result of any future direction from the JCDHE and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE).
