Hybrid Learning Begins Jan. 26

On Tues., Jan. 26, 2021, middle and high school students in the Shawnee Mission School District (SMSD) will return to in-person learning, using the hybrid learning model. Students whose families have selected remote learning will remain remote.

Hybrid Model Information

For families that have selected In Person/Hybrid Model, your students will start attending in person again the week of Jan. 26. Click HERE for Hybrid Learning Reminders. Your student has been assigned to one of two groups by last name. Here are the weekly schedules for both groups:

- A Group (Last Name A Lamb) Monday and Tuesday In-Person at Indian Woods / Wednesday and Thursday at home learning through activities assigned on Canvas / Friday Remote learning at home -
- B Group (Last Name Lamc Z) Monday and Tuesday at home learning through activities assigned on Canvas / Wednesday and Thursday In-Person at Indian Woods / Friday Remote learning at home

In-Person Learning Days: All students are required to wear a mask while on the bus and in school. Indian Woods will open doors at 8:20AM. Students not eating breakfast will report directly to their Wolf Pack classroom. Students may eat breakfast in the MPR before reporting to Wolf Pack. Wolf Pack starts at 8:45. Students will be dismissed for the day at 3:45.

Home Learning Days: Students are expected to remotely check-in with Wolf Pack at 8:45. Students will complete activities and assignments posted on Canvas for each class after attending Wolfpack.

Remote Learning Days: Students will remotely attend all classes including Wolf Pack.

Families that have selected the **Remote Only** options will continue with their current schedule.

DS Busing/Transportation Services

New this year, **SMSD** is requiring <u>ALL</u> students that want to receive bus service enroll online prior to the first time you ride the bus. This includes those that qualify for free busing. See information <u>HERE</u>.

Middle School Sports Resumes 2nd Semester

Once the district has transitioned back to the hybrid learning model, Indian Woods will resume all athletics, except wrestling. Middle school athletics will not take place while in the remote learning model.

To help keep our students safe during this time, middle school sports will not be competitive, but instead, will run clinics focused on skill building, rules and game strategy. There will be safety protocols in place in accordance with the Shawnee Mission Athletic Department, the JoCo Health Department, and the Kansas State High School Activities Association to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. An important part of these protocols involves maintaining cohorts, which means students will only participate in clinics on the days they attend school in-person.

If a child is a part of the remote-learning model, the days they will attend the clinics will be based on their last name.

- Mondays & Tuesdays: Group A Student last name begins with letters A-Lamb
- Wednesdays & Thursdays: Group B Student last name begins with letters Lamc – Z

Clinics will be held directly following the school day, running from 4:00 pm until 5:30 pm. Transportation to and from clinics will not be provided. Any student who would like to participate in the clinics will need to have a current physical on file, along with the Concussion & Head Injury Release signed. These can be found HERE (Spanish). Food Service

Meal pick up resumes on **Fri., Jan. 8**, 2021 and will continue on Fridays from 6:30-7:45 AM at all schools. Food service provides free meals to students regardless if they are in remote, hybrid, or in-person learning. This includes breakfast and lunch meals. Meals provided cover the days the student is not in-person learning (including weekend meals).

SMSD Food Services will be transitioning to a different pizza soon due to manufacturer challenges. The stuffed crust pizza that is a favorite of our students has been discontinued for the remainder of this school year. We will continue to have pizza on our menus. The new items will be added to SchoolCafé for nutrient and ingredient information. We appreciate your support and apologize for any inconvenience this will cause.

Free meals are offered to all SMSD students regardless if they are learning remote, hybrid or in person. This includes all breakfast and lunch meals. Meals are funded entirely by USDA. These **free** meals will continue through the end of the 2020-2021 school year. When students are in person, any extra ala carte purchases the students will need to have money on their food service account.


20-21 Inclement Weather Reminder
