

The Shawnee Mission Board of Education held a special meeting on Monday, January 3, 2022 to discuss the 2021-2022 Semester 2 Mitigation plan.

The Board of Education voted to uphold the 2021-2022 Semester 2 Mitigation plan as previously adopted on November 15, 2021. The Board approved this decision with a 4-3 vote.
