IW School Fees Due Feb. 12

Fee statements were sent to all students that have a balance due. Please check your student's statement for elective class fees. If your student is not enrolled in the elective class, please email patdeveau@smsd.org or call 913-993-0601 to remove the charge.

All required fees (book rental & ID) and elective class fees are due. You may make a payment at www.smsd.org/families/pay-fees. You may also call Mrs. DeVeau at 913-993-0601 to make a payment with a debit or credit card, or bring cash or check to door #1 and a receipt will be issued to you.

If your student has a Kansas Medicaid card (Kancare) with a status of 19 it will waive the book rental and ID card. If you don't know your status, Mrs. DeVeau can check your Kancare card number. Please email her a copy of your card or the Kancare number. She will notify you if you qualify. You will need to pay any elective course fees that your student is enrolled in. Please make your payments by February 12, 2021.

<u>Presidential Awards For Excellence In</u> <u>Mathematics And Science Teaching</u>

Nomination Deadline March 1, 2021.

The National Science Foundation is currently accepting nominations for the Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST) program. PAEMST are the highest honors bestowed by the United States government specifically for K-12 science, technology, engineering, mathematics, and/or computer science teaching. Up to 108 awardees may be recognized each year. The program alternates between K-6 and 7-12. This year nominations should be made for 7-12 educators.

Anyone--principals, teachers, parents, students, or members of the general public--may nominate a teacher by completing the nomination form available on the PAEMST website. To submit a nomination, you will need the teacher's name, email address, and school contact information. If you know more than one teacher deserving of this award, you may submit more than one nomination. Teachers may also apply directly at www.paemst.org.

Presidential awardees receive a certificate signed by the President of the United States; a trip to Washington, D.C., to attend a series of recognition events and professional development opportunities; and a \$10,000 award from the National Science Foundation. They also join a network of award-winning teachers from across the country. The National Science Foundation administers PAEMST on the behalf of The White House Office of Science and Technology Policy. The nomination deadline is March 1, 2021 and the

application deadline is April 1, 2021.
