Enrollment opens February 21, 2023, Deadline to enroll is June 1, 2023. Course dates are May 30 - July 25, 2023.

What to expect?

- Student should be a Self starter
- Must be your own advocate (it is your class not your parents)
- Must have excellent communication skills (emails), especially since it is an online course
- Remember it's a real class (like a online college course)
- 60-65 hours online coursework:
 video lessons, reflection, quizzes,
 tests, projects (different for Fitness)
- Health includes hands only CPR demonstration

Course Withdrawal and Refund Policy

- If withdrawal is made by June 20, 2023, no record will appear on the transcript. Any withdrawal requests made after 7/18/23 will not be honored and students will receive the grade earned on the transcript.
