Kansas State Assessment Testing Dates.

We wish to thank our families and especially our students for a successful week of testing this past week. Regular In-Person and Remote bell schedules will resume April 26. We will finish Assessment testing next week with for 8th grade Science and Remote students:

In-Person Students – 8th Grade Testing Next Week

8th grade In-Person students will take the Science Kansas Assessment test in Science classes April 27-28.

Remote Students

Remote students who have signed up to take the KS State Assessments at Indian Woods will take the tests April 27 (Reading, 7th and 8th grade), April 28 (Math, 7th and 8th grade), and April 29 (Science, 8th grade only). Please review the following guidelines:

- Each day's test session will run from 2-4 PM.
- Student's should arrive between 1:45-1:55 PM and enter the building through the main entrance. (Door # 1)
- Students must bring their MacBook (Charged).
- Students will be spaced 6 feet apart in the cafeteria, and will be kept separate from the inperson students.
- All students will be required to wear masks for the duration of each testing session.

Spring NWEA MAP Assessment

We will administer the Spring MAP Assessments in Mathematics and Reading the first week in May 3-7. MAP Assessments will be given in Mathematics and ELA classes. MAP will be given to both in-person and remote students.
