December 22 - Early Release Day

Tuesday, Dec. 22 is an early release day and the last day of school before winter break for students; the day will end at 1:45 PM. All middle school students in Shawnee Mission will be participating in an online extension day. Students will need to be in Wolf Pack at 8:45 AM, and will remain with that group throughout the day. Activities will include some fun games with their Wolf Packs, the opportunity to virtually attend the Shawnee Mission South winter play, and a service project. They will also have the opportunity to work with their teachers to get help on work they may still need to complete. Students will be guided by their Wolf Pack teacher as to lunch break schedules and what their choices are throughout the day.

Middle School Sports Resumes 2nd Semester

Middle schools in the Shawnee Mission School District will resume all athletics, except wrestling, during second semester, once the district has transitioned back to the hybrid learning model. Middle school athletics will not take place while in the remote learning model.

To help keep our students safe during this time, middle school sports will not be competitive, but instead, will run clinics focused on skill building, rules and game strategy. There will be safety protocols in place in accordance with the Shawnee Mission Athletic Department, the JoCo Health Department, and the Kansas State High School Activities Association to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. An important part of these protocols involves maintaining cohorts, which means students will only participate in clinics on the days they attend school in-person.

If a child is a part of the remote-learning model, the days they will attend the clinics will be based on their last name.

- Mondays & Tuesdays: Group A Student last name begins with letters A-Lamb
- Wednesdays & Thursdays: Group B Student last name begins with letters Lamc – Z

Clinics will be held directly following the school day, running from 4:00 pm until 5:30 pm. Transportation to and from clinics will not be provided. Any student who would like to participate in the clinics will need to have a current physical on file, along with the Concussion & Head Injury Release signed. These can be found HERE (Spanish). 
