Shawnee Mission School District recently requested that all parents acknowledge three assurances regarding remote learning. The request comes because the KS State Department of Education recently changed its requirements for how we verify student learning and attendance. Once you acknowledge the three assurances, we will no longer need to require that students complete and parents sign a daily learning activity log, which would have gone into effect once we entered hybrid learning mode. <u>Class Attendance and Participation Expectations</u> As you know, <u>being present and participating</u> in daily class activities ensures course knowledge and personal success. Each class session materials are presented to ensure sequential learning experiences.

We realize that this does not apply to all students and that some students learn better individually, but class attendance and participation is paramount.

Attendance Update

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we continue to navigate through the Remote Learning process.

The following attendance guidelines apply to ALL students. (In-Person and Remote)

- Teachers take attendance at the beginning of each class period. If your student is not present for roll call, they will be marked absent.
- If a student is unable to attend due to technical issues, please email the teacher.
- Unreported absences will receive an automated phone call at the end of each day.
- Parents and students may check attendance by logging into Skyward <u>HERE</u> and checking the "ATTENDANCE" tab on the left. This will detail absence types and class period.

If your student will not be in class due to an **appointment**, **illness**, or **any other reason** than a technical issue, please call the 24-hour attendance line at **913-993-0612 by 9:15 AM** and follow the prompts.

IMPORTANT: We ask that parents not send an email for your students' attendance, we need to have one location for attendance and calls need to be recorded on the 24-Hour Attendance Line.

School Fees

Shawnee Mission has **waived the Foods and FACS fees** for first semester classes. Those fees are removed in Skyward for all students. If you paid for Foods or FACS classes there is a credit on your student's account. Second semester, the credits will be moved to any fees that are owed by the student or to their lunch account. If you have questions about this procedure, please call Mrs. DeVeau at 913-993-0601. The fee shows as waived for those students that haven't paid their fees. The **online fee payment** program is available, please click <u>HERE</u> and pay your student's fees.

If students have a **medical card with the State of Kansas**, please email a copy of the card or the card number to <u>patdeveau@smsd.org</u>. Our bookkeeper, Pat DeVeau, will check the KANCARE status and notify you by email if you are not on the KANCARE 19 (TITLE XIX MEDICAID APPROVAL) program. The KANCARE 19 status waives the textbook rental and ID fees. Families will be required to pay any course or optional fees.

Checks and money order payments can be mailed to Indian Woods Middle School, 9700 Woodson Drive, Overland Park, KS 66207. Please go to the online program above to check the amount due for your student. Please also put your student's name and ID number in the memo section of your check and write your phone number on the check.

Payment arrangements for fees can be made by calling Mrs. DeVeau at 913.993.0601. Please have your credit or debit card available to make your first payment. You will be sent a payment plan by email that you will need to sign and return to the school.
